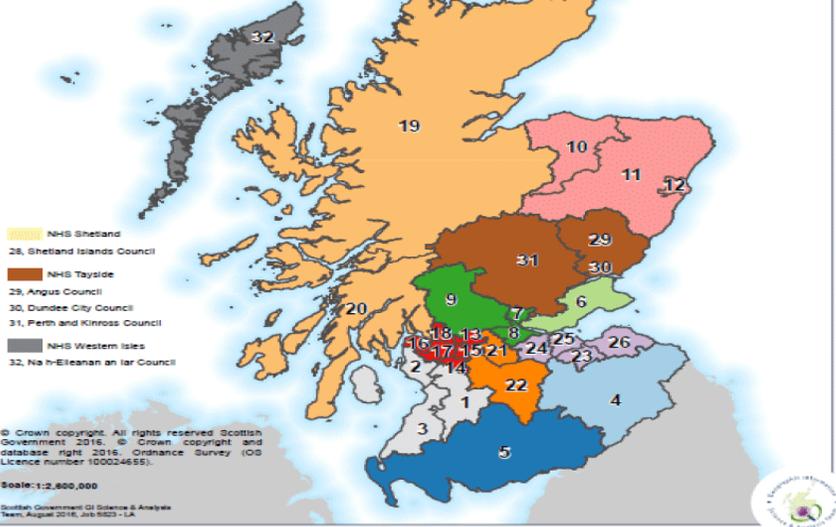

NHS and Social Care Delivery settings in Scotland

Real-world explorations, trials and testing of 'combinatorial' innovation (new combinations of products and processes)

Solving real problems and commercialising services and products

# Test Bed Examples and Impacts

Transformation in NHS/Social Care	Benefit to NHS/Social Care
Virtual Asynchronous (not real time) Consultations	20% time saving in Dermatology 90% plus patient satisfaction Reduced outpatient and cancer waits
Mammography and Machine Learning	Save 50% Radiology time and reduce breast cancer waiting time
Trauma App to Covid 19 Triage	Safer Clinical Decision- 8 week deployment of Covid 19 triage app
COPD-Prediction and Early Intervention	Avert one hospital admission per year-7 hospital days per patient-£9k
Neurology-Virtual Asynchronous Diagnosis	12% reduction in Hospital Admission Remote accurate home based diagnosis
Covid Assay-Test Development	New antibody and PCR assays and innovations to support Scotland's Covid 19 response

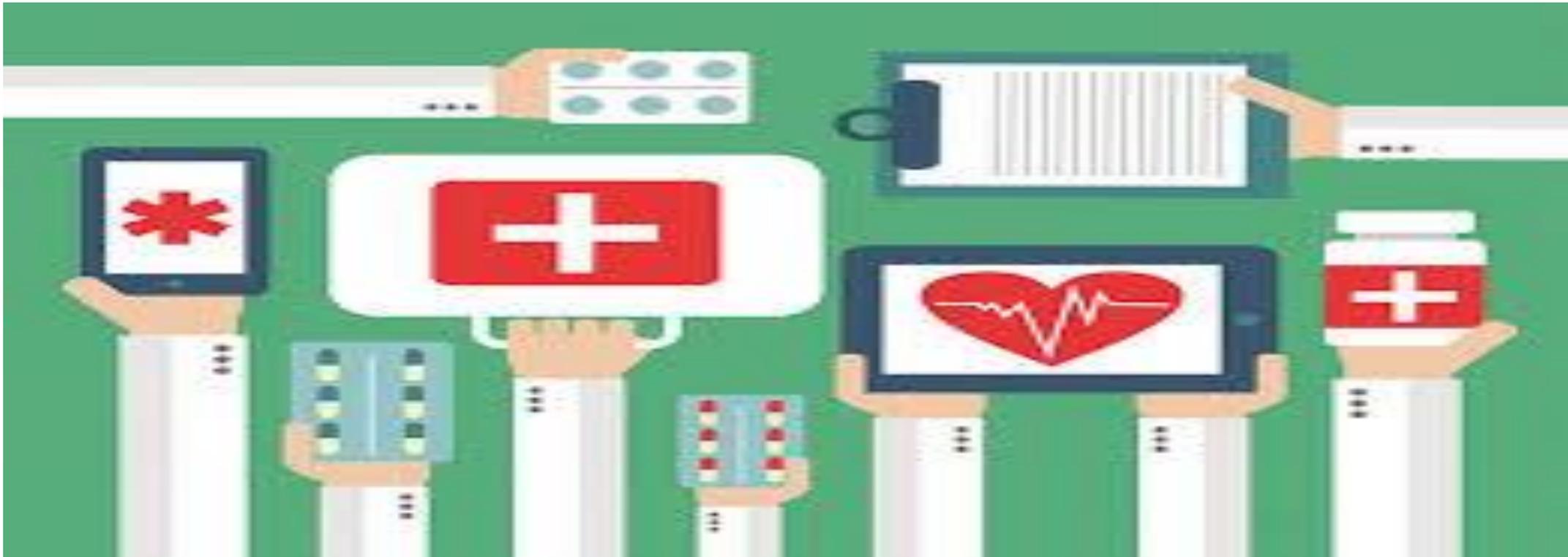
